TAACTIC, TO MEET WHAT NEEDS?

Digital exclusion is a phenomenon particularly affecting the least qualified and most vulnerable groups while reinforcing inequalities such as access to employment, certain trainings, essential services, etc.

In addition, basic skills (including digital ones) are too little valued in the training courses organised to date. Hence the usefulness of TAACTIC project that provides concrete responses to the needs of adult training professionals and learners.

Finally, it should be underlined that learners' autonomy will be strengthened through the training course initiated by TAACTIC.

TAACTIC, FOR WHAT RESULTS?

TAACTIC project aims to develop five outputs transferable in different learning situations:

- digital skills assessment
- common frame of reference for digital basic skills training
- pedagogical activities for basic skills training
- recommendations for training in digital jobs
- pedagogical resources for training in digital jobs.

TAACTIC, WHICH MEANS IMPLEMENTED?

TAACTIC project partners have adopted a demanding methodology and a rigorous quality approach based in particular on:

- an integrated didactic approach adapted to the trainees' learning needs;
- piloting outputs with learners in order to guarantee their performance and transferability;
- solicitation of partners' networks to feed the project with inputs from field experts.
